Definitions:

Mission: A definite community of Christian faithful entrusted to a priest as its proper pastor but not yet erected as a parish. A Mission is not seen as permanent: it is a temporary entity on its way, eventually, to becoming a parish. **Station:** A place where Mass is offered, located within the confines of the parish of the pastor who offers Mass. **Parish Number:** is the 3-digit number of your parish/mission for accounting purposes (e.g., Holy Name of Jesus Cathedral: 601; Saint Peter, Greenville: 706, etc.).

Priest(s) in residence apply to those priest(s) who live in the rectory or parish house/residence.

Lay Ministers: Dir. of Religious Ed, Music, Youth, RCIA, Liturgy, Business Mgr., Family Ministry, Etc., do not include support staff.

Other Priest(s) living within your parish boundaries: retired, students, unassigned, military chaplains, etc.
